

Brcue Grove Neighbourhood Management

Aims and objectives

The neighbourhood management strategy sets out to narrow the gap between the deprived neighbourhoods and the rest of the country. A Bruce Grove Strategic Group was set up in October 2004 to identify and develop the key objectives and priorities of the ward. The group is made up of local councillors, local residents, council officers, the police, youth organisations, schools and a representative from the Primary Care Trust. Through extensive consultation/feedback from residents and the neighbourhood board the following key objectives have been identified:

- Reduce levels of anti-social behaviour
- Improve built environment
- Improve community safety and reduce crime
- To ensure waste management meets local needs and that standards of cleanliness throughout the neighbourhood remain high
- To further develop greater community involvement/consultation
- Improve facilities for children, youth and older people
- Development of successful learning neighbourhood
- Address environmental safety and planning issues.
