### 2) SUMMARY OF ACTION ITEMS

### 3) MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

No record could be found of the minutes of the last meeting. Quincy Prescott will check to see if he has a copy to be brought to the next meeting.

#### 4) **MATTERS ARISING**

- DW introduced himself to the panel and briefly set out his aims and long-term goals for the ward. Requested that QP remain as ward Chair. This was agreed and supported by the whole panel. DW requests QP attend a Safer Neighbourhoods course on 6<sup>th</sup> December at the Civic Centre.
- General discussion regarding the frequency of panel meetings. QP suggests bi-monthly meetings with the addition of occasional meetings for specific purpose. NE suggests meeting dates should be set up to a year in advance and regularly i.e. 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday in month. All above suggestions agreed. Dates to be set after QP's course.
- DW raises ward panel make up and his intention to set up youth panel. Suggests main panel would set two policing priorities and youth panel one priority. There was then a general debate on the above. Main points below:

##### Main Panel

1. QP ward panel should have more community input. Suggests ward split into 5 areas then 2-3 reps per area to ensure at least one rep at each meeting. JB has two other suitable reps from Campsbourne Area. VB suggests Turkish member of panel may be useful as large community.
2. VB states she can only attend occasional meetings. MG & VB state, as work overlaps would ensure one of them would attend each meeting.
3. JB suggests occasional meetings between main panel and youth panel when set up. Generally felt inappropriate to have youths on main panel.

##### Youth Panel

1. DW explains difficulties encountered in setting up youth panel with general lethargy from schools.
  2. QP suggests very basic questionnaire sent out to schools to gauge interest.
  3. MD suggests Bluetooth message in area of school. VB states that ASBAT have the equipment to do this.
- There was then a very lengthy discussion regarding youth provision on the ward. DW stated his intention to get a youth club set up on the ward. JB, QP, VB & MD highlight similar projects in the past have met with problems over finance, location and interest. DW reiterates his desire and intention to do so. QP suggests setting a completion date of September 2009 for this to be set up.

#### 5) **UPDATES / CLOSURE OF PRIORITIES**

##### **ASB – Campsbourne Estate**

DW then gave update on the dispersal zone on Campsbourne Estate. Stated complaints of ASB down by 25% over summer period compared to last year. NE expressed serious concerns regarding the displacement of youths to St Mary's estate. MD explained extra

policing has already been requested for the area from other borough units as well as specialist teams.

## **DRUGS**

DW then gave update on closure order on 2 Harvey House and huge reduction in ASB complaints as a result.

### **6) PRIORITIES TO BE RATIFIED BY HORNSEY WARD PANEL**

Discussed and agreed that the previous set priorities will remain and will be reviewed at next meeting in December.
